Hello, I'm Jane, a NOMA neighbor and a Hospice nurse. I wanted to let you know about Hospice services that are available to you and your family.

In order to be eligible for Hospice, a person must have a life-limiting condition, be under the care of a physician, and not be seeking aggressive treatment (i.e. hospitalization or treatment for the illness).

We can provide care in the home, Assisted Living, Board and Care, or Skilled Nursing Facility.

The biggest mistake people make is waiting too long. It is of course, very difficult to accept that a loved one's life is coming to an end, but with enough time we can support both the patient and family in the most comprehensive way.

While on Hospice, if hospitalization or treatment is desired, Hospice can be revoked at any time and insurance benefits revert to their former coverage.

Hospice provides medical equipment, medications related to the diagnosis and comfort medications as well as the assistance of a bathing nurse, volunteers, Spiritual Care, Social Work and nursing visits. You do not have to go through this difficult experience alone.

You can interview several Hospices and choose the best fit for you.
