Tranquil Care Hospice Launches Telehealth and Remote Monitoring Program in Response to COVID Pandemic

Burbank, California - August 5, 2020 - Tranquil Care Hospice, a hospice organization based in Santa Monica, California, has announced a Telehealth and Remote Patient Monitoring program in partnership with Health Recovery Solutions (HRS).

With the resurgence of COVID-19 across California, Tranquil Care Hospice has turned to telehealth to provide symptom screening, 24/7 monitoring, and virtual visits to high-risk patients in their communities. In the coming months, Tranquil Care will expand the Telehealth program with the aim of reducing costly hospital readmissions for patients and their families.

Tranquil Care Hospice will utilize telehealth and RPM to quickly identify potential COVID patients through their recorded symptoms and vital signs. Clinicians can then triage potential patients through virtual visits, available via the telehealth platform. Telehealth patients will receive a COVID Care Plan with specific educational videos and symptom assessment surveys, as well as a mental health questionnaire so ensure patients are recovering safely from their homes.

"Our goal is to improve a patient's health, to objectively improve their functionality and independence, and to reduce emergency room admissions," says Reggie Rodriguez, Vice President American Homecares and Tranquil Care Hospice. "This Remote Patient Monitoring system effectively works to solve these issues, giving us the capacity to take our care to the next level."

For homecare patients and their loved ones, the Telehealth program provides an additional layer of support, providing a platform for virtual counseling sessions, enhanced pain management through 24/7 symptom and medication monitoring, and educational resources on advanced directives and more.
